

New courses, new tie-ups

Shiva Nadar University, Noida, has launched a global dual degree programme in engineering in collaboration with Carnegie Mellon University, Pittsburg, U.S. The course is available in Electrical and Computer Engineering and Mechanical Engineering.

The four-year undergraduate engineering degree programmes will enable a student to get a Bachelor of Technology degree from Shiv Nadar University and a Bachelor of Science in Engineering degree from Carnegie Mellon University. The course will begin in August and students will spend the first and third years at the SNU campus in Noida and the second and fourth years at CMU's Pittsburgh Pennsylvania campus, with opportunities to undertake summer internships in both the U.S. and India.

The admission process will start in February and applicants will have to meet both the SNU and CMU admission criteria, including taking the SAT and TOEFL exams.
