Regional collaborations

We have partnered with various grassroot organizations working across the country for our master's program on Rural Management. <u>Gram Vikas</u>, <u>Samaj Pragati Sahayog</u> (<u>SPS</u>) <u>Advanced Center for Water Resources Development and Management (ACWADAM</u>), and are some of the organizations that have done pioneering work over several decades in some of the most difficult management challenges facing rural India in areas of participatory water management, sustainable agriculture, rural livelihoods, women's empowerment, drinking water, sanitation, and innovation, to name a few. Students pursuing this course learn and receive training amidst the local communities and cultures as part of field education spanning across two semesters.

The Young Thinkers Forum (YTF) of the Shiv Nadar University collaborated with experts from the Centre for Environment Education (CEE) and HCL Foundation and organized a workshop for school students from different schools of Delhi-NCR on International Earth Day. The program is created to help students understand what it means to live sustainably and what they can do to reduce their carbon footprint, address climate change, risk mitigation, and the adoption of impact reduction initiatives. The workshop was conducted by Ms. Meera and Ms. Gayatri from CEE who also engaged students in storytelling, poster making and shared an engaging presentation about "Say No To Plastics". Our young visitors took back a lot of information and discussed the growing issues of climate change.
