Water conscious planting

Shiv Nadar University has taken into consideration the local weather and terrain for all its planting purposes. The university's huge campus has been carefully planned with water conscious planting including many arid and semi-arid plants on campus. The university does not remove old or native trees planted previously. Steps are taken to ensure their continued survival. We have ensured that biodiversity (including flora and fauna) and the terrestrial ecosystem is preserved. Careful consideration is also given to the use of optimal water-saving equipment on the campus like the drip-irrigation system for the landscaped gardens and use of treated water by the Sewage Treatment Plant.

Some of the water conscious planting activities undertaken are:

- The old Date Palm Forest was left intact during the construction phase, and it is a restricted area to protect and conserve the natural habitat of the associated wild species.
- The Natural Lake area has been restored and managed to provide a safe habitat for a wide variety of aquatic animals and plants. The slope of the landscape is such that the water naturally flows towards the lake.
- Water-conscious plants are planted in all building blocks, thereby resulting in a green campus and reduced irrigation requirements. The campus has many drought-tolerant plants, such as *Acacia auriculiformis* A.Cunn.ex Benth., *Albizia lebbek* (L.) Benth., *Casuarina equisetifolia* L. to name a few.
- The campus is home to many arid and semi-arid plant species of xerophytes promoting water conscious planting. These are:
