Improving State Capacity to Target Extreme Poverty: An Evaluation of a Randomized Intervention in Bangladesh

Abstract: To improve targeting of social policies, research has focused on incentives and accountability of local decision makers. This paper identifies local state capacity as another key constraint which has received little attention. We examine whether and how a locally implemented capacity building intervention including training and data provision for the national Old Age Allowance program in Bangladesh can improve targeting. The results of a large-scaled clustered randomized controlled trial in 80 rural municipalities show that the intervention enhanced the knowledge of eligibility criteria but did not improve the targeting performance. We further document that improvements in the targeting performance depend on selection committee's willingness to improve and that the illegitimate collection of fees from applicants influences the selection of beneficiaries.

PROMISE, SOCIAL IMAGE, AND VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO AN ENVIRONMENTAL GOOD

Abstract: This paper reports on behavioural experiments that contribute new understanding of the effect of upfront promise on pro-social behaviour. Existing studies in behavioural and experimental economics suggest that people have social preferences to keep their promises. We investigate how a policy maker can exploit such preferences to supply more public goods at less costs. We propose a mechanism and test experimentally that asking people to make a promise of contributing to a public good in front of an audience will ensure significant increase in contributions even when the actual contributions are made in private. This is because social-image concerned people will not make selfish promise and they will not break the promise even in private as they have a non-monetary cost of promise-breaking. In the experiment, participants are asked to make promise how much they are willing to give to an environmental NGO in front of other participants and researchers simultaneously. Next, they are asked to put their actual contribution in an envelope in private. Compared to a baseline where they promise and contribute in private, contribution increases significantly. Additional experiments to test subjects' preferences for promise keeping and social image provide support to our mechanism in that (i) those who have no preferences for keeping their words give almost zero while they promise to give a generous amount; and (ii) those who care more about their social image give substantially more than those who care less.

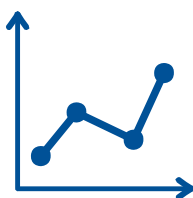

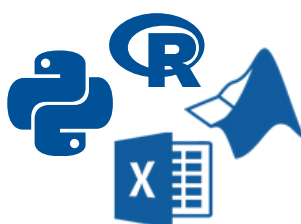

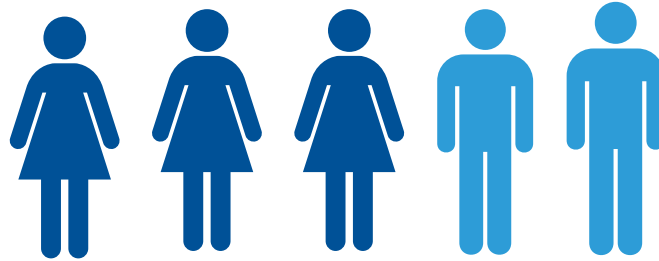
