Students with a known disability, requiring different academic and other accommodations will be covered under this policy. Disability Support Policy's objective is to extend support to students with different/special needs so that they benefit fully from their education and lead fulfilling lives. Disability Support Policy endeavours to encourage students to constructively and productively face challenges that may come their way during their educational pursuit at the university. We are devoted to making the university an inclusive space for students by promoting awareness about disabilities and working on improving physical accessibility on the campus. This becomes vital since SNIOE is a fully residential campus where students spend a large amount of their time.

- Policy of academic audits to be formulated by the academics department.
