### BACHELOR OF MANAGEMENT STUDIES

The Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) program has been developed as a unique offering in India. It provides the students with a strong foundation of specialized knowledge, experiential learning and opportunities for early global exposure. It is aimed at shaping students into well- rounded global who have broad citizens a multidisciplinary base of knowledge and a 'worldview'- Shiv Nadar IoE's special differentiator - along with depth and specialization in several joboriented and 'in-demand' areas in Management.

With path breaking offerings like The Venture Lab (TVL), where students build and execute businesses right from scratch, the goal is to give students the best of both worlds – versatility that prepares them for any career, including higher education and targeted acceleration into chosen career tracks.

**Core Courses:** Fundamental courses that equip students with a holistic understanding of business and management.

**Management Elective Courses:** Specialized courses across the domains of Finance, Marketing, Decision Sciences and Operations, Economics, Organizational Behavior, and Strategic Management.

**University Wide Electives**: Multi-disciplinary courses that allow students to explore their areas of interest in other disciplines across Shiv Nadar IoE.

**Core Common Curriculum**: A set of courses aimed to expose students to essential practice and knowledge from different categories.

**The Internships**: Structured programs to provide students with industry experience.

- Social Sector Internship: A 2-month internship with an organization in the development sector at the end of the second year.
- Business Sector Internship: A 2-month internship with an organisation in the corporate sector, at the end of the third year.

### SOCIAL SECTOR INTERNSHIP (SSI)

Social responsibility is one of the priority areas of the School of Management and Entrepreneurship. We want our graduates to be more responsible towards society and make them more humane and ethical. The social sector internship was introduced as a compulsory component of the BMS curriculum to serve this purpose.



The SSI is an opportunity to work on real-life projects with non-profit organizations (NGOs, government agencies, cooperatives, CSRs, etc.) under the guidance of eminent development professionals. During the internship, students work for eight weeks on projects assigned by reputed not-for-profit organizations.

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE SOCIAL SECTOR INTERNSHIP:**

- Understand the socio-cultural, political and economic factors and sensitize the students to different facets of the society.
- Understand the role and working of various institutions (formal and informal) in the developmental space.
- Explore the opportunities for doing business at the bottom of the pyramid.
- Contribute to developmental organisations by working on live projects.
- Understand the challenges faced by professionals working in the social sector.
