Shiv Nadar University's selection process has three parts:

Part 1: Eligibility based on Class XII scores as defined in the section - Eligibility for Admissions and Scholarships - Undergraduate Programs

Part 2: Shiv Nadar University Scholastic Aptitude Test (SNUSAT) and Academic Proficiency Test (APT) – A combined three hour test to be administered in more than 100 Pearson VUE test centers across India helping every aspirant to participate in the process. SNUSAT and APT will be available as per the details mentioned under section - Key Dates.

- If the same APT serves all the Programs that you have selected, no additional APT is required. For instance, all Engineering Programs require SNUSAT + APT code "1-A".
- If any of your Program preferences are mapped to a different APT, you are required to take the additional 1 hour APT(s). However, there is no need to repeat SNUSAT. For instance, when Program preference 1 is B.Tech. in Mechanical Engineering and Program preference 2 is B.Sc. (Research) in Mathematics, you first need to appear for SNUSAT + APT code "1-A" for B.Tech. in Mechanical Engineering. For B.Sc. (Research) in Mathematics, you will have to register, schedule and give an additional APT code "3-C".
- All the questions except the SNUSAT Essay and Critical Writing in APT will be Multiple Choice Type. There is no negative marking.
- SNUSAT Essay and Critical writing sections will have to be typed on the computer, within the stipulated time.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Shiv Nadar University's eligibility criteria is developed to shortlist candidates with subject knowledge which serves as the foundation for each program. While students are admitted to a specific program, the University offers flexibility to transfer to another program/school in the University after completion of one year in the program admitted to, subject to policies governing such transfer.

Fulfilling the eligibility criteria is only the first step and does not entitle a candidate to admission. The candidate needs to complete all the stages successfully to be offered admission to Shiv Nadar University. Also, the scholarships given below are indicative and the decision of Shiv Nadar University with respect to grant of scholarship will be final and binding depending on the performance in the selection process.

To provide a fair and equal opportunity to every aspirant, Shiv Nadar University normalizes the scores obtained in Class XII to even out the inconsistencies that exist between various Boards of Examinations. You can check your eligibility and scholarship based on your Examination Board and Class XII scores in the matrix below.

Shiv Nadar University is a comprehensive, multi-disciplinary, student-centric, research-focused institution. To further the advancement opportunities for students, the University since inception has offered merit based scholarships to all students. And, to recognize and reward students with exceptional talent; and students coming through constrained opportunities Shiv Nadar University has instituted two more scholarships for admissions into the undergraduate programs:

For Scholarship Recipients


- The students availing these scholarships will be required to meet the academic and non-academic performance criteria for each semester. For details on requirements, please refer to the Undergraduate Student Handbook 2018.
- In the interest of maintaining high Academic Standards, Shiv Nadar University takes this criteria very seriously and students are advised to concentrate on studies right from the time they join the University.
- If a student fails to fulfill the scholarship continuation criteria, he/she would be required to pay full fees for the rest of the program. The scholarship is reinstated in case the student manages to bring up their scores above the continuation criteria in the subsequent semesters. The fees paid for the duration that the student was not on scholarship is not refundable.
- The scholarship does not include courses taken beyond the prescribed curriculum or courses that may be repeated if not cleared in the first attempt. Course taken over and above the required credits will be charged for separately @ ₹ 6,000 per credit. A maximum of 7 credits can be taken during the Summer Semester.
- The hostel, tuition, mess and laundry fees for Summer Semesters (if required) will be payable over and above the fees given here. Summer charges are as follows :
 - Hostel - ₹ 13,500
 - Mess - ₹ 4,300 (Per Month)
 - Laundry - ₹ 450 (Per Month)
- In the interest of creating an egalitarian institution, the hostel configuration is pre-decided for all undergraduate programs as given below and cannot be changed:
 - 1st year: 2 students in a room
 - 2nd year: 2 students in a room
 - 3rd year: 2 students in a room
 - 4th year: Single occupancy
- A Hostel room may be upgraded or downgraded by the University based on rooms availability. In the event of a room upgrade there is no extra charge, whereas if a room is downgraded the student will pay lower charge applicable to that room type.
