The missed classes, if any, are compensated. During the pandemic, the classes were conducted online and after the initial opening of the campus, the classes were run in the hybrid mode. All the faculty and lab staff were trained to use online resources/tools for effective teaching and learning process. The classrooms in the University are equipped for hybrid learning. During the COVID period, most of the classes were conducted in hybrid mode, following the COVID-19 norms. The institution subscribed to the Microsoft Teams application for seamless functioning of classes and project work. The faculty, staff and students of the university, used it. The Tool for online assessment and evaluation were purchased for formative and summative assessments. The end term assessments were completed on time. Proctoring tools such as My Perfectice and Mettl were used during the examinations. All faculty and students were given access to e-content of the Shiv Nadar IoE library, all Journals subscription were made available to the faculty on request basis.
