The Department of History at Shiv Nadar University invites applications into the Ph.D program for **five** seats for the academic year 2019-20.

The Department of History at Shiv Nadar University offers Ph.D programs in both History and Archaeology.

The Department emphasizes a critical engagement and rigorous use of the sources, as well as the ability to generate data themselves to undertake innovative and creative research into past societies.

Candidates can submit proposals for undertaking research on any aspect of History and Archaeology, subject to the expertise of the Faculty (see below). Candidates can also check <https://history.snu.edu.in/> for further information regarding department faculty.

Eligibility

A candidate with at least 55% in their Masters degree in the disciplines of History, Archaeology, or Museum Studies can apply for admission.

The Ph.D program is open to those who have finished their Masters programs as well as those who have completed an M.Phil.

The above is a minimum standard and applications not meeting this will be rejected. Please note that not all candidates meeting the minimum eligibility criteria may be shortlisted. The University reserves the right to determine the number of candidates actually offered admission in any Program. This may mean that the number of students admitted into any program may be less than the number of seats declared.

Important Dates for Admission Procedure

The last date for receiving applications is **30th May 2019**.

Short-listed candidates will be invited for a written examination and an interview with Department faculty by **mid-July 2019**. The exact date for the examination and interview will be notified to candidates later.

Fees and Financial Assistance:

Detailed information about the fee structure and the nature of assistantships are available on the University website.

Full-time Ph.D students will get 100% Tuition Fee waiver and 70% Hostel Fee waiver. Selected candidates will also get a monthly stipend of Rs. 50,000/- for the first two years, and Rs. 55,000/- for the following two years. This is contingent on satisfactory performance throughout the duration of the program.

- Fill all the mandatory fields
- Online upload of the following documents is required:
 - Passport size photograph
 - Current curriculum vitae
 - All mark sheets/degree certificates (10th Standard onwards)
 - Standardized Examination certificate such as UGC-NET (if applicable)
 - Statement of Purpose (2000-2500 words, in a Word document, Times New Roman, 12 font, 1.5 spacing)
 - One writing sample (at least 6,000 words, in a Word document, Times New Roman, 12 font, 1.5 spacing)
- After payment and online submission, print the completed form and send by Speed Post to the University at the address given below with two sealed reference letters in support of your application. If the online payment option is not used, a demand draft towards the application fees may be enclosed.
